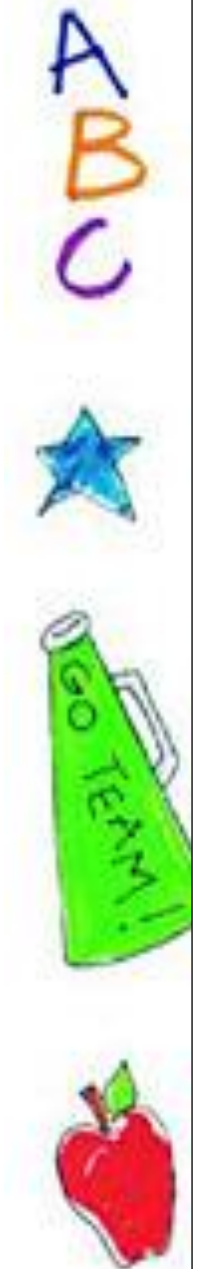


Senior Infants - Term 2 News

They have been learning all about spring time, made beautiful daffodils and we enjoyed going on a spring hunt around the school searching for any signs of spring.



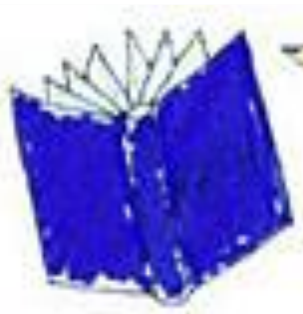


In science, Seniors Infants conducted an experiment to explore what conditions plants need for growth. The children planted cress seeds and looked after them very carefully.

Seniors loved learning about the life cycle of a frog and made frogs their own frogs during Aistear. The children painted lovely spring flowers during Art.

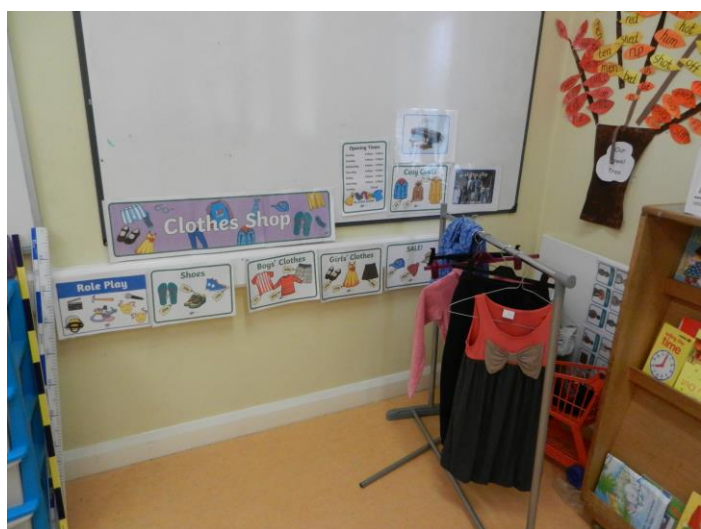
